9:00 am*	<b>Green Flag! Start of 1.5, 3 and 12 hour Endurance races</b>	Start is on Front Straight
10:30 am*	<b>Checkered Flag for morning 1.5 hour King of the Road Race</b>	Finish is on front straight Then circulate to track exit and hot pit lane.
~12:00 pm*	<b>Checkered Flag for morning 3 hour Ironman Race - Full Course Caution for some laps</b>	3 hour race cars to pit road
4:00 pm **	<b>Afternoon Ironman and King of the Road start, caution flags displayed on track briefly</b>	Pre-grid within paddock, enter through track entrance road when waved on
5:30 pm **	<b>Checkered Flag for 1.5 hour afternoon King of the Road Race</b>	Finish is on front straight Then circulate to track exit and hot pit lane.
7:00 pm **	<b>Checkered Flag for afternoon 3 hour Ironman Race</b>	Finish is on front straight Then circulate to track exit and hot pit lane.
7:30 pm	<b>Head and tail Lights must be on</b>	<b>sunset is at 7:33 pm</b>
~9:00 pm*	<b>Checkered Flag for 12 Hour Endurance Race</b>	Finish is on front straight

\* Race starts when green flag drops, races go 1.5, 3 or 12 hours from green flag drop time. Exact times of each morning and LA1k+ race starts and finishes depend on when exactly the green flag drops.

\*\*Afternoon Ironman and KoR races will start as close to 4 as feasible, regardless of initial green flag time.

LA1K+ Race will end at 9:30 pm at latest.
